International Baccalaureate Magnet Program

Campbell High School houses the only International Baccalaureate Diploma Program in the Cobb County School District. In eighth grade, students from throughout Cobb County have the opportunity to apply for acceptance into this rigorous academic program leading to the International Baccalaureate (IB) diploma. Students enter the program in ninth grade and take advanced-content, magnet-specific classes for two years (including Advanced Placement classes) before beginning the two-year courses that lead to the IB exams and the prestigious IB diploma. The IB students also complete a 4,000-word independent study project known as the Extended Essay, take a year-long "Theory of Knowledge" course that unifies their academic subjects and investigates the knowledge issues that underpin those courses, and participate in two years (often more) of consistent and meaningful community service. The IB students bypass some of the honors courses offered at Campbell High School in favor of Pre-IB and Advanced Placement courses. The students simultaneously complete all of the Georgia state requirements for high school graduation and earn a Campbell High School diploma.
