## INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE PROGRAM

The International Baccalaureate (IB) Program has been a part of CHS since 1997. It is the only IB program in the Cobb County School District. In eighth grade, students throughout the district apply for the program. Students enter the program in ninth grade and take advanced-content, magnet-specific classes for two years (including Advanced Placement classes) before beginning the two-year courses that lead to the IB exams and the prestigious IB diploma.

## 2017-2018 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- 371 students were eligible for the National Honor Society.
- Eight students received commendation in the 2019 National Merit Program.
- Delegation to the Model UN at UGA received third place.
- 22 students qualified for the Governor's Honors Program.
- 191 students were named an AP Scholar for their performance on the May 2018 AP Exams. 81 percent of students who took the exam at that time received a passing/qualifying score.
- The engineering class was selected as the only class in the country to Beta test a Lunar Rover Collaboration between NASA and Georgia Tech.
- A CHS student was the Cobb County Dive Champion and placed ninth in the State.
- A CHS student qualified for a spot on the Junior Olympic Fencing Team.
- The girls track team earned third place at the State Track Meet. This was the fourth year in a row the team finished in the top four at State, only two other (7A) programs in the state have done so over the same period of time.
- The girls track team earned second place at the Cobb County Track Meet.
- The boys tennis team placed second in the Region, and qualified for State. They advanced to the "Sweet 16."
- The girls tennis team placed third in the Region, and qualified for State.
- The boys soccer team were the Region 2 – 7A Champions and also advanced to the State Semi-Finals.
- A CHS student won the State Championship in the female wrestling category.
- The varsity baseball team made the State Playoffs.
- The marching band earned Best Percussion, Best Guard, Best Drum Major, and Best Visual Performance to secure a 2nd place finish at the Conquest Allatoona Marching Band Contest.
- A CHS student represented Georgia in the Macy's Great American Marching Band during the Macy's Thanksgiving Parade. He is one of two students from the state of Georgia chosen for this honor.
- The chamber orchestra and ninth grade orchestra were rated "Superior" in the Large Group Performance evaluation. Campbell's Intermediate Orchestra received an "Excellent" rating.
- The dance team placed second in two categories at the Georgia Inferno Spirit Dance and Cheer competition.
