➤ **UGA ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

UGA does not have a "minimum" SAT, ACT or GPA (grade point average) requirement. The Board of Regents in Georgia has established minimum requirements for applicants to the research institutions within the state. UGA's middle 50% from the 2014 entering first-year class exceeds the Board of Regents minimum requirements.
